Funds donated to and earned by the PA Foundation are awarded annually to clinical and scientific researchers who are constantly developing breakthrough medications and treatments.

The PA Foundation does not receive any funding from the State and Federal Government and relies solely on donations from the general public, the business community, bequests and the thousands of patients and their families who have benefited from the outstanding medical treatments thanks to years of successful research.

The first grant was awarded by the PA Foundation in 1988 and since then, the team has raised and distributed millions of dollars to all kinds of worthy research programs.

RESEARCH SAVES LIVES

In excess of 300 people in our research team are involved in programs that seek to find cures, treatments and preventions for a variety of diseases and injuries. Some examples of their research include:

CANCER - Hundreds of thousand of lives will be saved with the successful development and release of the cervical cancer vaccine

HEART - Many lives have already been protected by the diagnostic heart imaging procedures developed by research

ARTHRITIS - Our scientists are edging closer and closer towards developing a vaccine for rheumatoid arthritis

DIABETES - Researchers are currently working on developing an injection to prevent Type 1 diabetes in genetically-susceptible patients

LIVER - Many children's lives have been saved thanks to the liver transplant technique

KIDNEY - Renal research has resulted in improved outcomes and quality of life for patients with kidney disease

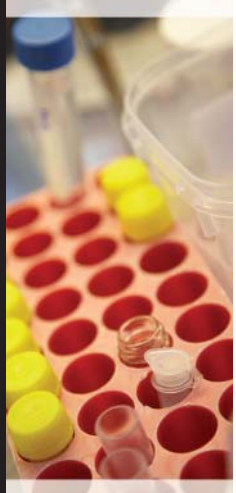
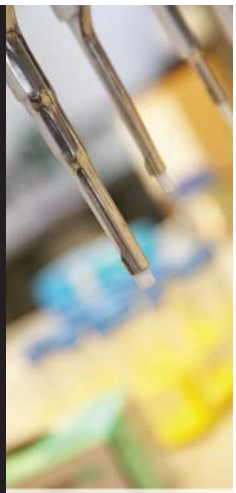
Tax Deduction
