Sling Bag

Pattern

You will need:

- ▶ 4 pieces of fabric – two for the outside of the bag and two for the lining. The fabric pieces both need to be 123cm long and 52cm wide
- ▶ Cotton thread
- ▶ Needle or sewing machine

Construction

- ▶ Fold each piece of fabric widthwise right sides together – forming a rectangle 23cm wide and 123 cm long
- ▶ Using the pattern overleaf as a guide (you can enlarge it on a photocopier or mark the shape on the fabric by hand with dressmakers chalk), mark out the pattern and cut out
- ▶ To give the bag more shape, you can fold a dart into the corners – remember it needs to be the same size and in the same places on all 4 pieces
- ▶ Unfold all 4 pieces and pin one piece of lining to one piece of outer right sides together.
- ▶ Sew a seam around the edges, leaving 1cm seam allowance.
- ▶ Don't forget to leave a small opening so that you can turn the fabric right side out
- ▶ Once you have done that, hand stitch the opening closed
- ▶ Repeat for the rest of the fabric
- ▶ Then, sew both pieces, right sides together. Turn right side out and TA DAH!
